The choir under the tutorage of Mr Bathols were very upbeat and sang with infectious gusto which had



School Banking

School Banking

School banking is held every Wednesday. Banking bags are in each classroom for children to put their banking pouches in from 8.30am when the classes open. The bags will then be collected by Mrs Wansi to process and the pouches will be returned to the children in their classes within the week.

ENROLMENT IMMUNISATION

Immunisation information for parents/guardians with children enrolling into kindergarten programs of schools

The Western Australia Department of Health in undertaking an awareness campaign to remind parents/guardians to ensure their child's immunisations are up to date and that they need to provide their child's Australian Immunisation Register (AIR) Immunisation History Statement upon enrolment into kindergarten programs and school.

Current Regulations

From 1 January 2019, new regulations under the *Public Health Act 2016 (WA)* require the parents/guardians of children enrolling into kindergarten programs and school to provide their child's Australian Immunisation Register (AIR) Immunisation History Statement, to the person in charge.

When requested to do so, persons in charge are required to report children whose immunisation status is 'not up to date' to the Department of Health where this information will be used to support families to get their child fully vaccinated.

Further proposed legislative changes

Legislative changes are also in progress that, if passed, will require (with rare exception) a child's immunisation status to be 'up to date' as a condition of enrolment into child care services (long day care and family day care) and kindergarten programs.

Parents applying to enrol their children into kindergarten programs for 2020 need to ensure their children's vaccinations are 'up to date' to avoid their enrolment being declined.


