PRIORITY MAINTENANCE PROGRAM

Our school has been informed from our Department of Education, funding allocations as part of the \$200 million High Priority Maintenance and Minor Works program. The High Priority Maintenance and Minor Works program for our school will consist of :

Phase 1 - Maintenance allocation to our school:

sees every public school share in \$35 million to address maintenance needs. It is intended that this funding is primarily directed towards addressing items identified on the school's Building Condition Assessment Report. Our school will receive funding of \$26,000 this term to commence Phase 1 works.

Phase 2 - Targeted Maintenance/Refreshment:

is targeted maintenance programs that will be Department of Education funded and allocated to work through the Department of Education's Building Management and Works using local contractors, with an amount of \$159, 059. This is to be spent over the next two years on programs such as classroom

refreshment; structural integrity of facilities; and car parks and traffic management.
