Attendance at Kindergarten is optional; however, it is recommended that all eligible children attend to develop foundational skills in literacy, numeracy and social interactions. As Orange Grove PS is a non-local intake school, attendance at Kindergarten does not guarantee a place in Pre-primary for the following year in 2023. All applications are assessed on distance to your home from school, if application numbers exceed vacancies.
