As you will be aware, the Department of Education has been undertaking significant preparation to ensure schools are as safe as possible. This includes dehumidifiers, were necessary, and the provision of an air quality monitor in common areas and teaching areas, a complete review of ventilation across the school, and an assurance that the school will be supported if there is an adverse finding.

It is pleasing to report that all students settled in well for their first week of the school year. I would also like to extend a warm welcome to all our new families especially to our Kindergarten children and their parents and caregivers and hope that your journey at this school will be a very rewarding one. I hope that everyone had a safe and refreshing break ready for another special year of schooling at Orange Grove Primary School.

I would like to thank the Orange Grove Community for being so understanding and patient during these uncertain times as we seek to put our students first!

#### Medical

Is Your Child Feeling Unwell?

Please do not send your child to school if they are at all unwell. A child who is sick will not be able to perform well in school and is likely to spread the illness to other children and staff.

Any child who demonstrates or complains of being unwell will be removed from the classroom, isolated and parents/ carers contacted.

Our school is well stocked with hand sanitiser. This has been provided to all work areas (including classrooms) and children are expected to "sanitise out/sanitise in" at all times. Cleaning of hands following toilet use is also instructed.

#### COVID-19 safe schools

Principals are to remind staff and students to remain home if feeling unwell. If they have any COVID-19 like symptoms, get a COVID-19 test and remain home until a negative COVID-19 test result is received. Further information about symptoms can be found on heathywa.wa.gov.au. A reminder that students who are unwell, symptomatic or test positive to COVID-19 should stay home and will be marked as an 'N' code when parents/carers notify the school, as per the normal process.

#### **Helmets**

A reminder that it is a requirement that students wear a suitable helmet whilst riding to and from school. Bicycles must be wheeled in to the school grounds to the bike racks near the office, and out of school grounds down to Boyle lane.

#### **Voluntary Contributions**

The total amount of contributions that parents and caregivers are being asked to pay has been contained to \$45.00 (discounted to \$40.00 if paid by 31st March 2022) and is within the \$60.00 maximum set in the School Education Regulations (2000). Money collected will be used to supplement school expenditure in the areas as follows:

While contributions are voluntary, the quality of our teaching and learning programs will be maximised when all families make their contribution to the cost of supplementing funding gained from other sources such as State and Commonwealth Governments.

#### Charges for Extra Costs—Optional

The Charges Schedule includes costs associated with the following

- Specific learning activities offered to all students but conditional upon payment being made e.g. incursion, excursions.
- Specific learning activities offered to selected students but conditional upon payment e.g. Instrumental Music etc.
- Specific learning Soundwaves and iMaths books contributions towards work books.

 Other activities available to all students but conditional on payment being made e.g. Graduation, camp etc.

#### **Interm Swimming**

This year has seen our swimming lessons moved to Cannington Leisure Centre. With this comes an increase in the cost, approximately \$10 per child. For those who paid for 2 weeks of lessons last year and only completed 1 week, you will have a credit for the week they did not attend.

#### **Class Meetings**

Just a reminder that the new COVID-19 regulations not allowing parents to enter the class rooms has seen these meeting cancelled. We thank you for your understanding and continued support with these matters as they arise.

#### **Carpark Safety Rules**

A reminder to all parents and caregivers to please observe the road rules in the car park and Kiss & Drive to keep all our children safe. If you have young children please ensure that you keep hold of them when walking to or from your cars for their own safety and please do not leave young children unattended in the car in the car park.


